Jane by Jane Lockhart is a new line of chairs, sofas, sectionals and ottomans that takes the guesswork out of furniture selection.

And it's all about matching. There are 240 specially selected fabrics for the collection, sorted into 42 co-ordinated colour palettes to make choosing fabrics easier.

Not that she would eschewing popular trends like bright and bold colours, but Canadians are conservative, and more often than not, opt for more long-lasting, classic style in beige, grey and neutral colours.
